ILPMP Implementation of Account Creation for Illinois Controlled Substance License Holders Begins

ILPMP, in cooperation with Illinois Department of Financial Professional Regulation (IDFPR), has the ability to determine active Illinois Controlled Substance License holders in the State. In phased outreach, ILPMP will automatically create ILPMP accounts for Controlled Substance License holders who do not have an ILPMP account. Providers will be contacted via e-mail to claim their accounts.

FDA Seeking Public Comment on Potential New Standards for In-Home Opioid Disposal Products

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued a [Request for Information \(RFI\)](#) seeking public comment

on potential new standards for in-home opioid disposal products. This effort is part of the agency's broader work to combat the opioid crisis.

Illinois PMPnow Integration Update

The Illinois PMPnow team is in the process of resuming integration requests. We appreciate all users' patience during the development of the new process.

Changes to the Illinois Controlled Substance Act have allowed for integration vendors to connect healthcare facilities and EHRs. Currently, two of the three approved integration vendors, LogiCoy and Leap Orbit, are live.

The development of the other approved integration vendor is ongoing; this vendor is Bamboo.

This new process requires a Memorandum of Understanding to be completed between the healthcare entity and the State of Illinois.

ILPMP Policy Update: Designee Account Access Limited to In-State Users

To strengthen data confidentiality and ensure the integrity of our verification processes, a new policy has been implemented that limits designee account access to individuals located within the state effective April 1, 2026. Under this update, designee accounts will no longer be authorized for individuals residing outside of Illinois.

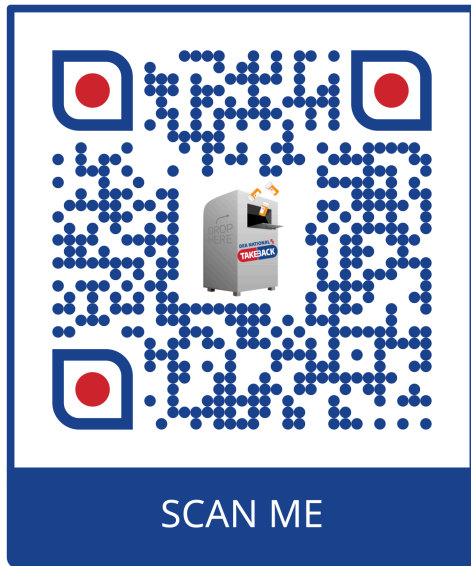


IDPH Releases Statewide Semiannual Overdose Report

ILPMP PHARMACY COMPLIANCE



Thank you to all pharmacies, pharmacists, pharmacy management systems, and submitters who worked diligently to transition to the updated reporting format ASAP 5.0!

We are delighted to announce that **73%** of the 3817 active Illinois Licensed Pharmacies transitioned to the ASAP 5.0 reporting format. Pharmacies that hold an active Illinois Pharmacy License and have not transitioned to ASAP 5.0, should expect to receive communication from our team in the near future.

A majority of the pharmacies that **did not** transition to ASAP 5.0 were **out of state pharmacies**. As a reminder, out of state pharmacies that hold an active Illinois Pharmacy License are required to submit:

- Reportable dispensations daily by end of day
- Zero reports daily for days no reportable dispensations occur
- Waiver if not dispensing schedule II thru V and/or drugs of interest to the State of Illinois. Apply for a waiver [here](#).

Reminder of reportable dispensations for retail pharmacies:

- Schedule II, III, IV, V Controlled Substances
- All Butalbital Combination Products
- Gabapentin
- Muscle Relaxants
- Opioid Antagonists

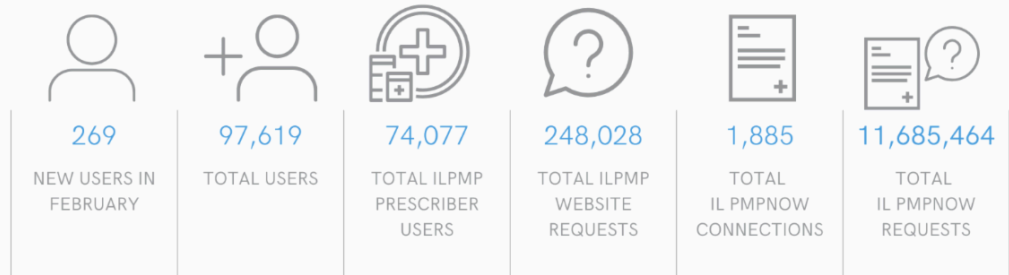
